The quorum for voting shall be 3 members of the Committee present at the meeting. Voting may be by a secret ballot and a motion will be carried if a simple majority of those present are in favour. Where the votes, including that of the Chairman of the meeting, are equal, the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote.

The Secretary will record the business of the meeting in the Committee's minute book ("the Book") which will be signed by the Chairman. The Book shall be available for inspection by any member of the Garden Committee on request to the Secretary of the Committee.
